LOCATION: Amsterdam, The Netherlands

DESIGN: Doepel Strijkers Architects

Before setting out to design the first flagship store for Dutch women's apparel brand Stills, architect Eline Strijkers established her own interpretation of the label: "Classic with an avant-garde edge and an eye for detail," she says. Taking cues from the company's collection, which includes warm natural materials such as wool and cotton, she and her firm used texture as a starting point and wood as muse, filling the 2,000-square-foot shop with a floor-to-ceiling 3-D grid.—JORDAN KUSHINS
